“CELLOBRATION!”

This performance is the culmination of the week’s intensive study by seven talented young musicians, students of celebrated cellist and inspired teacher, Yehuda Hanani.

The Cello Seminar takes place far from the commercialism and pressures rampant in today’s art and music world. Outstanding young students ranging in age from 15 to 22 gather for individual instruction and master classes, communal meals, early morning hikes (the rest of the day they practise!) and renewal in the bucolic surroundings of Chatham, New York with renowned cellist and pedagogue Yehuda Hanani. “This is a week guided by self-motivation, a Conservatory amidst fields and streams, connecting music back to its sources,” says Hanani.



Mr. Hanani is Professor of Cello at the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music where he directs the international “BachAnnalia” festival, drawing string players from around the world for weekends of immersion in the music of J. S. Bach. As Artistic Director of the Close Encounters With Music chamber music series in the Berkshires, South Florida, and Scottsdale, Arizona, he presents an innovative approach to programming that explores the common roots of all the arts. Soloist, chamber musician, master teacher and ambassador for the arts, Yehuda Hanani inspires audiences the world over. Mr. Hanani’s studies were with Leonard Rose at the Juilliard School and with Pablo Casals. We in the Chatham area are fortunate to have such a gifted performer/teacher as our neighbor.
